Supply List

Items to remain at school throughout the year:

Closed toes indoor slippers with backs and traction/rubber soles.

Water Bottle labeled with your child's name (these will be sent home at the end of each week to be washed).

Waterproof <u>neoprene</u> boots (no rubber boots please). We highly recommend *BOGS* or *Okiwear*, which are both insulated, flexible, and don't crack as easily as rubber boots. Children wear boots every day to allow for water and mud play. If you plan to bring your child's boots home over the weekend, they need to come back to school at the start of the week.

1-2 changes of weather appropriate clothing in a zip-lock or wet bag. We will provide a canvas bag that will travel back and forth between school and home as needed.

Daily Attire for Fall/Winter:

Your child should come to school every day wearing the following items:

Base Layer (fleece, silk, or wool - NO cotton)

Fleece or wool pants (NO cotton or jeans)

Fleece or wool zip up or pullover sweater

Puffer jacket. This needs to be well-fitted and fit under their school rain coat.

Weather appropriate items as needed: fleece or wool hat and gloves.

1-2 full changes of weather appropriate clothing in a zip-lock or wet bag. We will provide a canvas bag that will travel back and forth between school and home as needed.

Daily Attire for Spring/Late Summer:

Your child should come to school every day wearing the following items:

A variety of layers (both sweater/pants and shorts/t-shirts as morning can be cool and afternoons warm. Quick-dry and SPF clothing are best.

Weather appropriate items as needed: sunscreen (applied before drop off) and sun hat.

*Children need to come to school ready for the day. If they do not have adequate clothing, you may be asked to bring those items in order for your child to participate in the day. *

^{*}Sweet Honeybee will provide rain suspenders and rain coats for outdoor time. *

Place Mat Photo Collage

We would like each family to prepare a simple collage with your child that we will use as their placemat during meal times. Our intention behind this project is that this will be something you make as a family to help remind your child that even when you are apart, you can think of each other and have a physical reminder that you are connected. Feel free to draw or paint a picture together and add at least one family photo. Since we will put these through our laminator and they will need to be sanitized regularly, only use flat items such as photos, stickers, or cut paper. Also, do not add anything that will hang over the edges of the paper and it would be helpful to leave a small margin around the edges so that it will seal properly when it is laminated.

Specifications:

Prepared on a piece of printer paper size 8 ½ x 11

Include at least one family photo

Stickers or cut paper may be added but all items need to be flat and glued to the paper.

All items need to fit within the perimeters of the paper. We will need to cut anything that goes beyond the edges so that it can be sealed properly when laminated.

Emergency Care Kit

*All items should fit into a one-gallon zip lock bag. These items will remain at school for the entire year and will only be used in an emergency. Please write your child's name on the outside of the bag.

Change of clothes

Comfort item such as a small stuffed animal or a trinket

Disposable bottle of water

Non-perishable, **nut-free** bar/snack item

Family photo
