Schedule:

- Our preschool program runs September-May and we loosely follow the Seattle Public Schools break Calendar.

Responsibilities:

- Work with children ages 2.5-5
- Collaborate with other teachers to plan, prepare, and lead “age-appropriate” projects, stations, and activities.
